

ORDINANCE 151—VILLAGE OF STETSONVILLE

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 150.01 AND 150.06 E OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF STETSONVILLE

The Village Board of the Village of Stetsonville do ordain as follows:

SECTION 150.01 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Stetsonville, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 150.01 A retail “Class B” liquor license shall permit the holder to sell, deal and traffic in intoxicating liquors, in the original package or container, in quantities not exceeding one gallon at any one time, for consumption off the premises.

SECTION 150.06 E. of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Stetsonville be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

150.06 Regulations. All licenses shall be granted subject to the following regulations:

E. No premises for which a Class B Intoxicating Liquor license has been issued shall be permitted to remain open for the sale of liquor:

1. Between 1:00 AM and 8:00 AM (except during that portion of the year for which the Standard Time is advanced under Section 175.095 of the Wisconsin Statutes and the closing hours shall be between 2:00 AM and 8:00 AM) and except on January 1 when the closing hours shall be between 3:00 AM and 8:00 AM

2. Hotels and restaurants whose principal business is the furnishing of food and/or lodging to patrons shall be permitted to remain open for the conduct of their regular business but shall not be permitted to sell intoxicating liquors or fermented malt beverages during the hours mentioned in subparagraph 1 of this subsection.

The amendments effected by this ordinance shall be in effect and be enforced immediately upon its adoption and posting in the manner prescribed by law.
