

ORDINANCE 152—VILLAGE OF STETSONVILLE
AN ORDINANCE REALTING TO THE NUMBER OF PERSONS AND PLACES TO
BE LICENSED FOR THE SALE OF FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES

The Village Board of the Village of Stetsonville do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The number of persons and places that may be granted Class A Retailer's licenses, and Class B Retailer's licenses in the Village of Stetsonville, shall be and is hereby limited to the number of persons and places who, or that, held such licenses on January 1, 1952.

Section 2. This ordinance is adopted for the welfare, best interests and good order of the Village of Stetsonville, and the inhabitants thereof, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Village Board hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or otherwise not valid.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting.
