REMINDER—The village has a **property maintenance ordinance** that's purpose is to protect public health, safety, and welfare by establishing "**minimum**" property standards. We all wish to live in a neat and tidy community, so please do your part in keeping your property maintained! **This includes cutting of long grass, trimming of weeds, and keeping your property free of litter, rubbish, unwanted furniture or appliances, unlicensed vehicles, or other debris.** Penalties will be imposed for those who have been warned to clean up their property and refuse to do that.

ALL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE COMPLAINTS MUST BE IN WRITING, and will only be considered if it is submitted. The form is available on the website or at the village office. Please drop in box outside or in the hallway, or mail/email them to the office. If you have concerns, please contact a member of the board.

Recycle and Trash site is open Wednesdays from 5 pm to 7 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm. A 13 gallon/ regular kitchen bag is \$3 and a large barrel is \$5. ***Please have small bills/exact change when paying for the disposal of your trash.*** As always, recyclables are free to dispose of. The site is at the shop, by the water tower, on the southeast corner of the village. If you wish curbside service, then you must contract it independently.

GFL DROP-OFF. Anybody may take large items such as furniture, mattresses and other debris directly to the GFL transfer site at 645 Jensen Drive, Medford. Phone 715-443-5281. Minimum cost to dispose of these items is \$42.86 per ton, so make it worth your while! Phone 715-443-5281

Compost Site- *THE LEAVES WILL SOON BE FALLING OFF THE TREES.* ☹️ The village yard and garden waste collection site is located to the east of the Water Tower. Please pay attention to the rules—no large tree branches/logs, no plastic pots/bags, no garbage!! Materials allowed are grass, leaves, small twigs and branches diameter less than 4", and garden waste.
