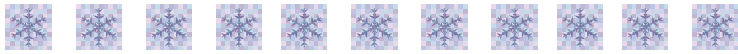

SNOW – SNOW and more SNOW - Just a reminder that Ordinance #247 prohibits parking on any public street from November 1st to April 1st between the hours of midnight and 7:00am to allow for the removal of snow. **Please cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the streets between these hours.** Everybody wants the streets to be clear early and the DPW employees start clearing very early in the morning, even before we are awake, so that the streets can be clear for you to get to work, appointments, or school!

BOARD MEETING - Is Monday, February 9, 2026 at 4:00pm at the JMTM Library. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend! If you wish to speak at public comment time or on an agenda item, you must call the Village office at least 5 days prior to the meeting to be placed on the agenda. Agendas are posted on the website and at the Village Hall, shop, and post office.

TAX PAYMENTS – The first half of your 2025 property tax payments were due to the Village Office by January 31, 2026 or must have been postmarked the same date. The second half of your payment is due to the Taylor County Treasurer by July 31, 2026. Please do not bring your second payment to the Village Office.

DOG LICENSES EXPIRE 3/31/2026. A valid certificate of rabies vaccination is required to issue tags for your dog(s). Failure to license can result in a \$169 fine.

CHICKEN PERMITS –Chicken permits are valid from January 1st through December 31st and must be renewed annually. The cost is \$15. Rules and applications are available on the Village website.



BRRRRR...IT'S COLD OUTSIDE! – Extreme cold is here. Remember, if you are cold, so are our furry friends. Make sure your pets time outside is limited to keep them safe. Don't forget to check on your family, friends and neighbors.

MEALS ON WHEELS/NUTRITION SITE - Meals are served on Tuesday and Thursday at 11:30am at the Centennial Hall for eligible participants. Contact the Commission of Aging Office at 715-748-1491. Cost is \$5 per meal. Home delivery is also available to those who qualify. Those who receive delivered meals receive the daily meal plus a meal for the next day. The ARDC Office has much to offer to our seniors, not just meals, but support, education, transportation, and entertainment, just to name a few items.

ELECTIONS – There is NO primary election this year. Spring General Election is Tuesday, April 7, 2026. Please go to **My Vote Wisconsin** to register or apply for absentee ballots. **You need to re-apply each year for absentee ballots.**

COMPOST SITE – Christmas trees are accepted at the compost site. The Village does not offer curbside collection.

HOUSE NUMBERS - PLEASE post your house number so that it is visible from the street, preferably near the front door facing the street near the door jamb.

REMEMBER - IF YOU SEE SOMETHING HAPPENING IN THE VILLAGE REQUIRING THE SHERIFF'S DEPT- CALL THE TAYLOR COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPT. The village has no control over speeding, fireworks, dogs running loose, speeding etc. These are state laws!
