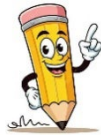

COMPOST SITE – The leaves are getting ready to turn! Please remember that **THERE IS NO CURB-SIDE LEAF PICK-UP**. Please take leaves and other garden and yard waste to the compost site. Remember that the compost site accepts brush less than 4", twigs, garden waste, and leaves. **DO NOT** bring any garbage, plastics, metal, rubber, logs over 4" or anything that isn't organic. Please pay attention to the signs on where items should be unloaded.

RECYCLE!!! – All recyclables are **FREE!** The Recycle Site is located by the water tower on East Mink Ave and is open on Wednesdays from 5:00pm to 7:00pm and Saturdays from 9:00am to 1:00pm. The success of our community recycling program depends on resident participation. The more residents that use and support the recycling program, the stronger the program becomes and the greater the opportunity for the Village to receive continued funding and support for recycling services.



VILLAGE POLICY CHANGE ON OVERDUE UTILITY BILLS – Beginning **January 1, 2027**, the Village will implement an updated utility billing policy regarding overdue balances. Utility accounts with a past-due balance exceeding **\$10.00** will be subject to late fees and may have services disconnected until the account is brought current. This advance notice is being provided to give residents ample time to bring any existing overdue balances current before the new policy takes effect. Residents are encouraged to make payments by the due date to avoid penalties or interruption of services.
