

**VILLAGE OF STETSONVILLE, TAYLOR COUNTY, WISCONSIN
RESOLUTION 2026-01**

RESOLUTION INCREASING SANITARY SEWER SERVICE FEES

WHEREAS, the Village of Stetsonville provides sanitary sewer service within the sewer service area and maintains a separate Sewer Fund to isolate costs and revenues to operate the sewer utility; and

WHEREAS, the Village is completing a regionalization project which includes an upgrade to a Lift Station, new forcemain, and abandoning the Wastewater Treatment Plant (the "Project") that it is planning to fund with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Clean Water Fund Loan Program.

WHEREAS, in 2026 the Village's Municipal Advisor, Ehlers, completed an evaluation of the historical and projected Revenue Requirements under the framework for rate-making provided in the American Waterworks Association M1 Manual;

WHEREAS, in order to close on the Clean Water Fund Loan Ehlers identified a need to produce additional revenues in the Sewer Fund; and

WHEREAS, Ehlers have reviewed the Sewer Fund's cash flow and identified a sewer revenue adjustment of 96% is needed in order to close on the Clean Water Fund Loan; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 61 Section 11 which was amended to Ordinance 62 Section 11, authorizes the Village Board to change user charges from time to time as it may deem advisable and sewer service charges are hereby changed with the values identified below as of August 1st 2026.

*Unmetered customers are charged the base rate plus assumed 6,000 gallons per month.

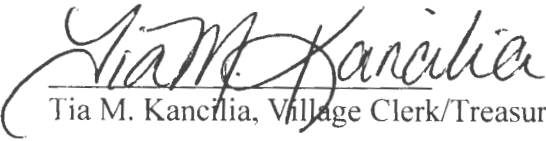
